Re: 2025 MotoGP™ PT Grand Prix of Thailand at Chang International Circuit, Buriram THAILAND

Dear Thailand Customs and Immigration Officers

We are pleased to inform you that Thailand is scheduled to host the Motorcycle World Championship “2025 MotoGP™ - PT Grand Prix of Thailand” at Chang International Circuit located at 30/2 Moo 4 Tambon I-san, Muang Buriram, Buriram which consist of 2 events:

- **WINTER TEST:** MotoGP™ Test - from 12th to 13th February 2025
IDEMITSU ASIA TALENT CUP – from 21st to 22nd February 2025
- **RACE:** PT Grand Prix of Thailand 2025 – from 28th February to 2nd March 2025

It is anticipated that there will be several individuals entering the Kingdom of Thailand for the Events pursuant to the Visa Waiver Program as tourists and/or business visitors for a period of 3 – 29 days, depending on their personal circumstances and business purposes.

Sports Authority of Thailand, the Promoter and Dorna Sports, S.L., the Spanish based company that holds the rights of FIM MotoGP™ Road Racing World Championship, have entered into an agreement to bring MotoGP™ a world class motorcycle competition to the circuit of Thailand as the sixth times.

The MotoGP™ event in Thailand has emerged as a standout example of the sport tourism policy in action, positively impacting key sector such as sports, the economy, tourist and country's global reputation. In 2024, the event attracted a remarkable 205,343 spectators, generating over 4.759 billion baht in revenue.

The anticipated arrival in the Kingdom of Thailand will begin in the second week of February 2025 for the test until the competition event is over on 2nd March 2025. Riders, mechanics, staffs and organization will be travelling throughout Thailand until the next schedules MotoGP™ race in other country.
